COASTAL MARVEL


- It Takes A Nation To Make Brunei Environment Clean -

MARINE DEBRIS IS ONE OF THE KEY ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS AT NATIONAL, REGIONAL AND GLOBAL LEVELS. THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, PARKS AND RECREATION (JASTRe) HAS OBSERVED THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THIS ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUE AND DECIDED TO EMBARK ON A NATIONAL-SCALE MARINE DEBRIS CLEAN-UP THIS YEAR. THIS CAMPAIGN WILL COVER SEVEN BEACHES ACROSS BRUNEI DARUSSALAM TO COLLECT BASELINE DATA OF MARINE DEBRIS IN THE COUNTRY.

GENERAL GUIDELINE

DO's

- The safety of everyone is of utmost importance during the beach clean-up. Only proceed with the clean-up when the weather is safe for outdoor activities.
- Participants are required to dress appropriately i.e. sport attires and closed shoes with thick soles. NO SLIPPERS.
 - Remember to bring trash bags to collect the waste and please use gloves to avoid any injuries.

DON'Ts



Do not touch with bare hands on anything that you are not sure/know of.



- Do not touch or pick up sharp or suspicious items on the beach such as broken glass, needles, syringes.
- Do not touch any washed up dead animals on the beach.
- Do not touch any hazardous chemicals you may encounter during the beach clean-up.
- Do not attempt to move large items such as lumber, furniture, drums. Inform the organiser about the location.
- You are not allowed to go into the waters during the clean-up and keep a safe distance back from the tideline as strong waves might be expected.

SEGREGATION GUIDELINE

- Identify the different types of marine debris. The common ones: Plastic containers/bottles, Metal cans, Glass, Styrofoams, Fishing gears, Fabric.
- Collect the different types of marine debris according to their own category and place them into the color coded trash bag respectively.
- Once you have finished collecting, go to the Assembly Point with the filled trash bags with you to be weighed using a weighing scale.
- Submit the completed data sheet to the organizer for data collection purposes.
 - The submitted report will then be compiled and updated on the Milestone Board by the Department of Environment, Parks and Recreation.
